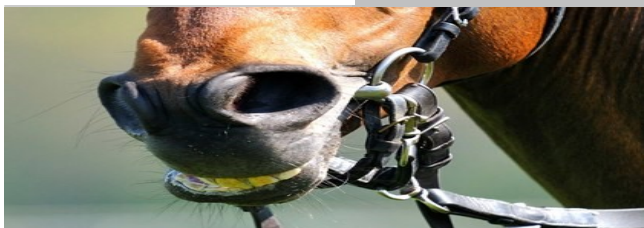

An Introduction to Modern Equine Dentistry

This course is aimed at new or recent graduates, or those interested in increasing their understanding of what is required in the field of equine dentistry.

The objective of this course is to equip Veterinary Practitioners with the practical skills and expertise to practice modern equine dentistry. There is a practical aspect with the use of cadavers which will cover the following skills: Detailed oral examination; Use of mirror/light source; Pathology recognition; Handrasping techniques; and Balancing and profiling techniques.

Places are limited to 12 delegates to facilitate the practical aspect of the course.
