## URINARY TRACT MEDICINE

1st May- Galway (12.30pm – 8.00pm) – The Clayton Hotel  
21st May- Dublin (9.30am – 5.30pm) – The GreenIsle Hotel

This course is aimed at small animal veterinary practitioners with an interest in urinary tract disease. A large part of the course will be centred on the diagnosis of renal disease and discussion on the importance of monitoring and early treatment. Common lower urinary tract diseases will also be covered with special emphasis on diagnostics and appropriate use of therapy in these cases.

The following topics will be discussed:

- Diagnosis of renal disease: common challenges in blood and urine interpretation
- Updates on treatment of acute kidney injury
- Monitoring and treatment of chronic renal disease: what is important?
- Proteinuria: what is its clinical relevance?
- Urinary incontinence: diagnostic challenges
- Urinary tract infections and appropriate use of antibiotics
- The cat with lower urinary tract signs

### Rory Breathnach MVB MSC MRCVS PhD

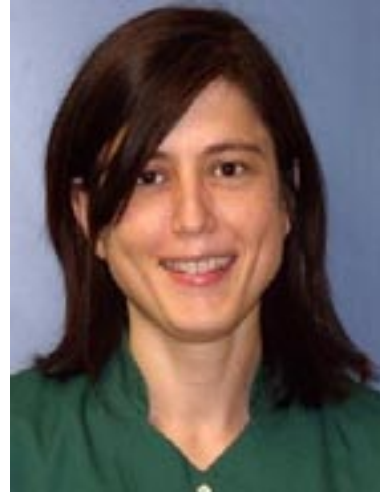
